

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES

You may be aware that Brooklands will be hosting an inaugural Half Marathon.

The aim is to bring a high profile event and raise awareness of the Brooklands and Weybridge area as well as bringing benefits to local businesses and charitable causes.

The half marathon starts and finishes at Mercedes - Benz World with the first 3 miles and last 3 miles of the 13.1 mile route on the Mercedes-Benz World site. To ensure the safety of competitors on the rest of the route, some road closures will be in place. The road closures will be managed by 'Combined Service Provider' (CSP) and warning signs will be put up on effected streets several weeks before the race.

The event organisers, 2:09 Events Ltd, are working closely with Surrey County Council, Elmbridge Borough Council and Surrey Police to ensure that disruption is kept to a minimum. Provision is made for Emergency Services access onto the route.

Arrangements are being made with Surrey Care Services to ensure home visits etc are not compromised. For specific enquires about disabled or carers' access during the half marathon, please contact the race enquiry line: 01252 373797.

TIMING

To reduce the impact on local residents, the race will start at 8:00am. There will be a 'soft closure' from 7:00am until 8:00am which, under the supervision of qualified marshals, will allow local access. The roads will then be closed from 8am to 10am.

Most runners will be back in Mercedes-Benz World by 10am, any remaining competitors will be moved onto the pavements and roads will be open to traffic. Cars parked on the route will not be able to be moved between 8am and 10am.

ROAD CLOSURES: 07.00 - 10.00hrs

The closed roads are as follows: Brooklands Drive (Except for access after 08.30) Wellington Way Brooklands Road (Wellington Way to Weybridge Station) St George's Avenue Queens Road (St George's Avenue to Monument Hill) **Oatlands Avenue** Oatlands Chase Oatlands Drive (Oatlands Chase to Bridge Street) Walton Lane/Thames Street, Monument Hill Hanger Hill.
