FINAL INFORMATION - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Thank you for your entry into the Longleat 10K or 2 Mile Fun Run. We would like your day to go smoothly and be as enjoyable as possible. All the information you need, you will find below.

RACE PACKS

Your race number with the timing chip attached is enclosed – please secure your number onto the **front** of your running top on the day. Take care not to damage the timing chip by bending or removing it as this could result in your race time not recording.

START TIME

10am – 10km race and 2 mile fun run start together. You should aim to arrive and park no later than 9am.

DIRECTIONS BY CAR/ PARKING

Address for Sat Nav: Longleat, Warminster, Wiltshire, BA12 7JS. Please ignore the Sat Nav voice as you approach Longleat and follow the brown tourist signposts.

What3words location for Longleat entrance gate: **///inefficient.outlast.narrate**

Once in the park, drive past the front of Longleat House and follow the signs and instructions given by marshals. There is no cost for runners and spectators to enter the Longleat Estate on race day or to park in the official car parks. Please note: The Park Attractions are closed on the day of the event.

T-SHIRTS

If you have pre-purchased a Longleat 10K race T-shirt you can collect them from Race HQ (What3Words location: **///magical.third.lotteries**). There will be a limited number of T-shirts available to purchase on the day for £12

BAGGAGE/ KEY DROP

The baggage/key drop area will open from 8:30am on race day and will be located next to the Race HQ tent alongside the Chameleon Tree Coffee House. (What3words location: **///magical.third.lotteries**).

You are welcome to leave your belongings with us but (if possible) we suggest leaving valuables in your vehicle. The baggage area will be manned at all times, but we cannot guarantee the security of your belongings. Anything left in the baggage area must be tagged with the label from the bottom of your race number. That includes your car keys. **Belongings will only be returned to competitors who present a race number that corresponds to the number on the tagged baggage.**

TOILETS

Male and female toilet blocks can be found in the Main Square. Please note there are no changing or shower facilities available. There are no toilets in the vicinity of the start/finish area. There is no baggage store at the start/finish either.

THE START & PACE SEEDING

The start assembly area is on Lodge Drive facing the front of Longleat House. It is approx. 10 mins walk from the car park/ toilets so leave plenty of time to get to the start. We will be operating voluntary seeding. At the start there will be placards placed at intervals along the start area road indicating running pace, sub-7, sub-8 and sub 9-minute mile pace etc. Please line up at a time slot that equates to your predicted running speed to ensure everyone can run freely in the first kilometre. The race is chip timed so your time will start when you cross the start line.

THE ROUTE

The race starts on Lodge Drive facing the Longleat House and then turns left and left again through Highwood where there is a 1K climb to Horningsham Village, returning down Lodge Drive to the start (the 2-mile Fun Runners will finish here). 10K runners continue through the finish line on a second loop that goes past the House and caravan park before passing the water station at approximately half way, taking a left and a short hill. The loop circles back towards Longleat House before going back up to Highwood to repeat the first loop. The finish is on Lodge Drive.

SUPPORTERS

Supporters can enter the grounds free of charge and should park as directed. Please arrive before 9:30am as the car park will be cut off by the start of the race after this time. Longleat House and attractions are not open on the day. Note: **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED** on the Longleat Estate

TRAFFIC

The race is mainly on the private roads of the Longleat Estate except for a short section through Horningsham Village where runners will be directed by marshals to keep left, although there is unlikely to be very much traffic on Sunday morning.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

The event is covered by CODEBLUE MEDICAL SERVICES, a professional event support medical service. There will be a Medical Tent in the start/ finish area. On the route, a mobile First Response Unit will be based at What3words location: **///duty.paces.cuts**. If you see someone in trouble between drink stations, please report it to the next marshal on the route who will be able to call up medical support.

DRINKS STATIONS

There will be water and HIGH5 Energy products at the drinks station at approximately 5K and at the finish. Please deposit your water cups in the recycle bins provided at the drinks stations. Please only drop HIGH5 gel wrappers in the designated recycle bins, there will be additional rubbish bags for general waste.

LITTER and GRASS AREAS

Please do not drop litter along the course or anywhere on the estate grounds as it is dangerous for the deer and wildlife. **We also ask that you keep off all taped grass areas.**

PRIZE GIVING

Prizes will be awarded to the overall first, second and third place female and male winners of the 10K on the day and will take place soon after the third place finisher in both categories has finished. Age group winners for the 10K will be contacted once results have been verified and awards will then be sent out.

REFRESHMENTS

Tea, coffee, soft drinks and snacks will be available for purchase from the kiosk alongside the restaurant in the Main Square.

RESULTS & PHOTOGRAPHY

Results will be available soon after the event from our website www.209events.com/uk-running-events/
